### That Place for Teens - Brunswick

That Place for Teens is a drop in center for middle school students located directly across from the Brunswick Middle School. We meet with students several times a week, sharing a family style meal with them, helping them with homework and looking for opportunities to share God's love.

They were asked to complete the sentence "Without this place, I would...". I would like to share with you the impact you have made in the lives of teens.

I have now attended Garage for around 3 years now. Today I can say with confidence that Garage & Coach Mountjoy have allowed me to grow in my faith. I am surrounded by a bunch of my buddies, eating, and learning about the Bible. It doesn't get better. — DJ age 16

My anger has changed. I would look at God as my Savior. That Place For Teens is real fun and you learn about Jesus. – Ray age 13

I am more connected with God. I feel that He loves me more. – Dee, attending for 3 years.
